Habitat for Humanity MetroWest/Greater Worcester builds and sells homes to local families who need affordable housing using volunteer labor and donated materials.

A Habitat home is a strong foundation for a family, an opportunity for them to build a better life. Better, affordable living conditions lead to financial stability, improved health, and the ability to make good choices for the future.

With a decent place to live and an affordable mortgage, homeowners have more money left over to pay for essentials such as healthy food, medicine, transportation, and to save for education. Through shelter, we empower.

Partner Families

We use three criteria to select families for our home build program:

- 1) Need for adequate shelter
- 2) Ability to pay a monthly mortgage
- 3) Willingness to partner with Habitat

These qualifications ensure that families are eligible to receive affordable housing per our guidelines, have a strong desire to work for their goal, and will have the ability to pay for their home over a 25 or 30 year mortgage.

Sweat Equity

Habitat builds homes with families, not for them. Partner families invest 300 hours building their own home or volunteering on another Habitat project.
