PARKING DETAILS: Parking is available in the 51 Providence St. lot, space dependent. Owned by Worcester Academy, they have given us permission to use the lot. It is a one-minute walk to the site. There is also parking along Harrison St. and the surrounding streets.

Our mission is to build homes, communities and hope for local families and veterans in the Greater Worcester and MetroWest areas of Massachusetts. We serve 42 cities and towns in the region. Under the motto of "a hand up, not a handout," we build houses **with** families rather than **for** them. Partner families must contribute 300 hours of sweat equity building their homes and learning skills to become successful homeowners. They also pay back an affordable mortgage, based on their income.
