What: For the fourth year in a row, Habitat for Humanity MetroWest/Greater Worcester is benefiting from a clothing and soft textile drive. Our Board President, Julie Davenport, and volunteer, Julie Bowditch, are once again spearheading the annual effort.

Donations can include clothing, shoes, bedding, towels, etc., must be clean and gently used, and should be placed in trash bags of any size. A monetary donation will be received for the textile donations and will benefit the local families and veterans who need a safe and affordable home in our communities. This event is generously sponsored by UNITS Moving and Portable Storage of Northeast Massachusetts and Rockland Trust.

Where: Worcester ReStore Parking Lot, 640 Lincoln Street, Worcester. The storage receptacle is outdoors, and volunteers will be on-hand to receive the donations. (If donors cannot make the drop dates, listed below, they can drop off at any local Rockland Trust branch during business hours.)

When: Sunday, April 14th; Saturday, April 27th; Sunday, May 5th, and Sunday, May 11th, from 9:00 AM until Noon. Vehicles can “drive-through” and have the donations taken out of their car if they prefer. **Note: Donations for the clothing drive CANNOT be accepted inside the ReStore.**
