Each veteran family preselected a theme such as New England Patriots, Cozy Cottage, American Flag/Patriotic, Barnyard, Castle, Log Cabin, or Firehouse based on their children's or grandchildren's interests.

After a day of hard work by each of our partner teams, the military and veteran families arrive between 3 and 3:30 PM for a playhouse dedication ceremony. The child is surprised and delighted, and it is a touching, personal, and heartwarming conclusion to the day. Each team will meet the family, spend time with them, and learn about the military or veteran's service to our country. The children are excited to play in their playhouse.

"Playhouses are constructed in one day, providing a wonderful team building opportunity and benefits local veteran and military families—something that is very important to Habitat and our partners. At the end of day, our partners will meet and dedicate their playhouses to each of the families. The children of these families are excited to have a 'home' of their own," said Habitat for Humanity MWGW Vice President of Philanthropy Deborah Huegel.

Habitat for Humanity MetroWest/Greater Worcester is the only Habitat affiliate in Massachusetts, and one of a handful throughout the U.S., to offer this program to veteran families.
