Make A Difference with Us

Many families in our community are **priced out of homeownership**, and face living situations that are unsafe, unhealthy, too crowded, or otherwise unaffordable. **Your support empowers** local low-income families to build independence by owning their home.



What We Do

Our mission is to **build homes, communities and hope**. We do this by partnering with local low-income families to build and repair affordable homes in the 42 cities and towns we serve right here in **Middlesex and Worcester counties**. Families contribute 300 hours of sweat equity helping to build their home, taking readiness courses, purchasing the home based on their income rather than the value of the home.

Be A Part of Something Transformative

In response to the **ongoing housing crisis**, and with the help of a generous 3.5 million leadership gift from MacKenzie Scott, in 2023, we launched the first year of an ambitious 3-year strategy to build 30 homes locally in 3 years. To date we have partnered to **build or repair 101 homes helping families** in our community build strength and stability and self-reliance through **affordable homeownership**.

Ways to Participate

Affordable Home Builds

We build affordable homes for local low-to-moderate income families and veterans. An affordable home builds strength, stability and self-reliance. Your team of 8—10 can take part in a Build Day, helping to build the home hands-on.

Home Repair

Our Home Repair program is an outreach initiative that seeks to provide home repairs for families who are struggling to maintain their homes. The program focuses on health, life, and safety/code issues.

Women Build

Women Build provides the opportunity for teams of women (and men!) to take the proactive step of helping local women improve their living situations. Teams fundraise, are sponsored, or both. They build with us for a day, a memorable experience that makes a meaningful impact. Over 75% of Habitat homeowners in our community are women.

Veteran's Build Initiative

The Initiative helps veterans through our programs: Affordable Home Builds, Home Repairs, and Operation Playhouse.

Gift-in-Kind Donations

Materials, services, and labor are always needed for our affordable home builds. Examples include electrical, carpentry, plumbing, flooring, roofing, paving, lumber and so much more!



Operation Playhouse

- Build a playhouse for a veteran family with your team of 8-10.
- A unique volunteer event hosted at **YOUR LOCATION** if a 30' x 40' space is available.
- An inspiring **hands-on team building** event where you learn new skills and have fun, while **giving back** to veterans.
- Meet the veteran family at the end of the day, and present the playhouse to them.
- We build **outdoors** early May—October; **indoors** November—mid April.
- All proceeds benefit our mission to build **homes, communities and hope** with local veterans and families.
